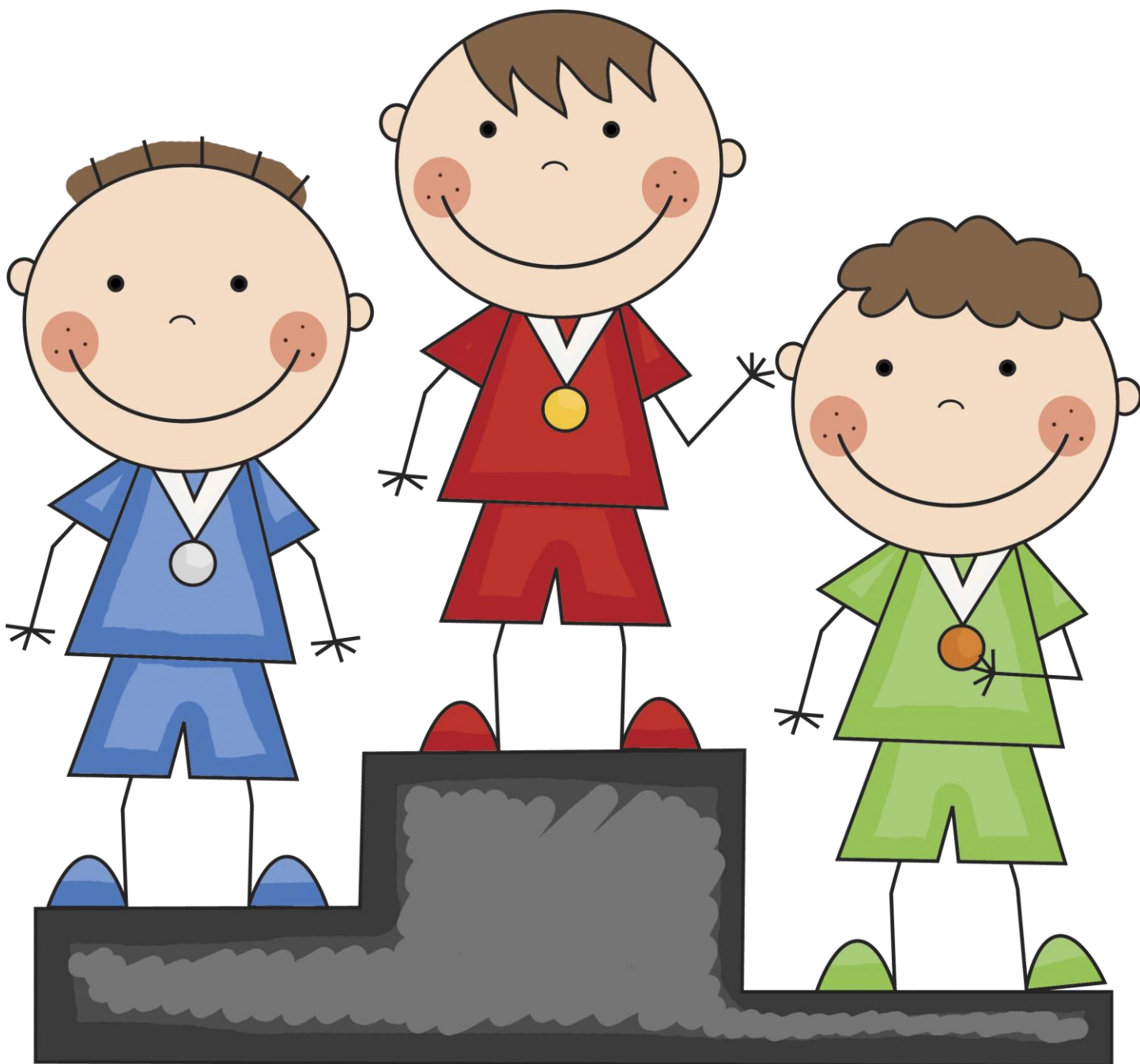

Gold = 1<sup>st</sup> Place



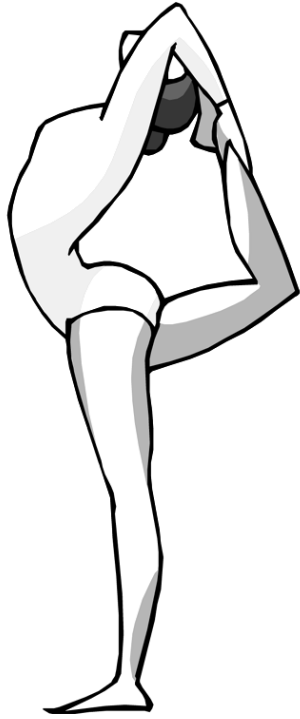

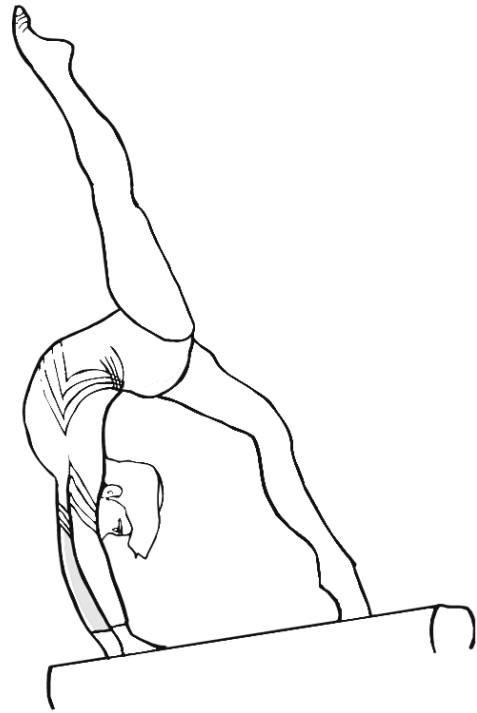

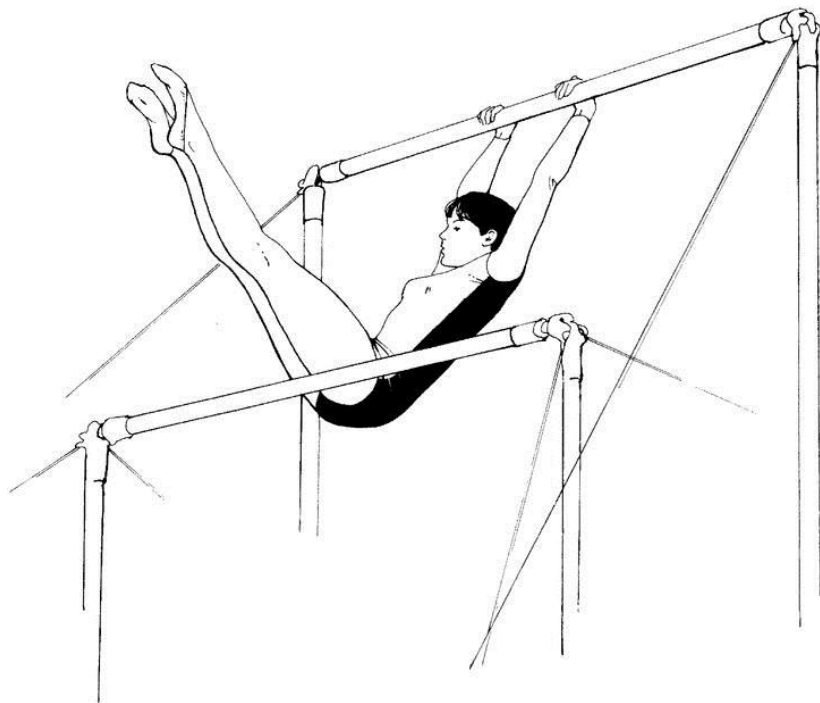

Floor Routine

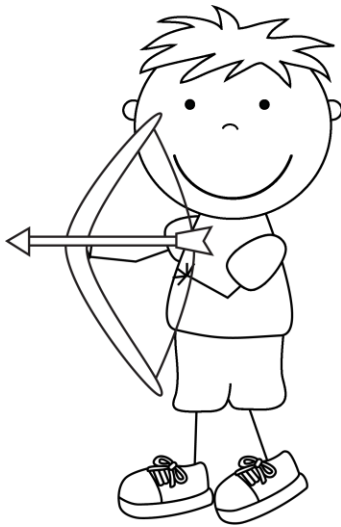


Balance Beam



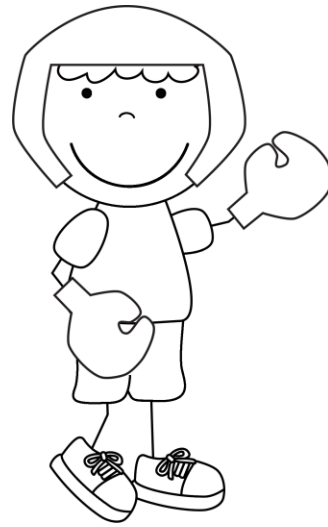

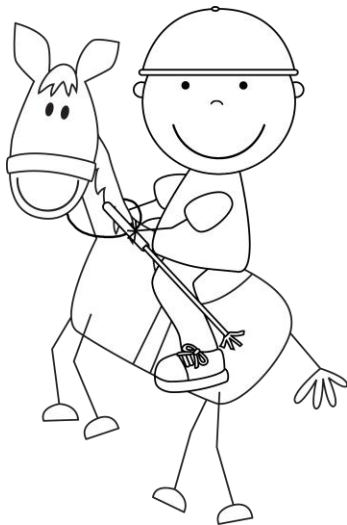

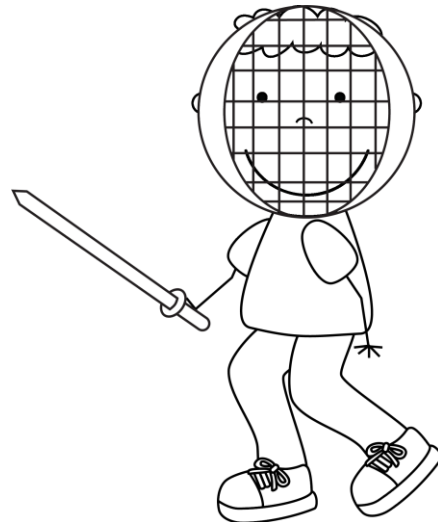
